- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to requiring school districts to develop a drug testing policy.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 5 and enacted as follows:

6 School boards - Drug testing policy.

7 The board of each public school district shall adopt and implement a policy providing for

8 random drug testing of all school district employees. For purposes of this section, "employee"

9 includes administrators, teachers, coaches, ancillary staff, and any other individual who

10 receives remuneration for services provided to the school district. The policy must:

- 11 <u>1.</u> <u>Require testing for part-time and full-time employees;</u>
- Require testing of every individual seeking employment with the school district during
 the hiring process;
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>Require random drug testing of at least ten percent of all school district employees in</u>
 <u>each twelve-month period</u>;
- 16 <u>4.</u> Provide an employee may not be subject to random drug testing more than once in a
 17 <u>twelve-month period;</u>
- 18 <u>5.</u> <u>Allow the board of the school district to review all drug test results;</u>
- 19 <u>6.</u> Provide the refusal of an employee to take a required random drug test is equivalent to
 20 <u>a failed test;</u>
- 21 <u>7.</u> <u>State the consequences for a failed drug test by an employee;</u>
- 8. Require termination of employment if an employee fails more than two random drug
 tests; and
- 24 <u>9.</u> <u>Require the school district to pay for all drug testing and related expenses.</u>
